

BYLAW NO. 222 / 2008
“Amendment to Boat Hoist and Lift Bylaw”

Being a Bylaw to amend the Boat Hoist and Lift Bylaw 212 /2006

Pursuant to Part 17 of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Summer Village of Silver Beach make the following amendments to Bylaw 212 / 2006:

That all references to boat lifts and hoists shall be replaced by “boat lifts, hoists, docks and piers”, and

That Part 1 is renamed “Regulation of Boat Lifts, Boat Hoists, Docks, and Piers.”

That Part 1 be amended by adding the following Item 1, and the existing items be renumbered accordingly.

1. Any boat lift or hoist, pier, dock or similar item that is stored on Silver Beach public lands beginning October 1st of any year through May 31st of the following year, and/ or is placed in waters abutting Silver Beach public land for the summer must display a permit tag. Items placed on public lands without permit tags and items stored on public lands between June 1st and September 30th will be subject to removal by the village.

That Part 1 be amended by adding the following Item 6.

6. Piers and docks may only be placed or stored in those areas designated by the Summer Village of Silver Beach, for example, the north portion of Ouimette Park and the water abutting the north portion of Ouimette park, and other approved areas. The south portion of Ouimette Park is a federally designated Swimming Area, and the placement of piers, docks, hoists and lifts is not allowed.

That Part 1 be amended by adding the following Item 7.

7. Trees and shrubs on public lands may not be removed or disturbed to create storage areas for the items referred to in this bylaw.

That Part 2 be amended by adding the following Item 5.

5. When residents are granted a permit, a permission letter from the upland owner as required under the rules of the federal Navigable Waters Act will be issued by the village when the item is stored or placed in water abutting Silver Beach Public lands. Items that are placed without permission on water abutting public lands may be reported to the federal authorities, and these items may be subject to removal.
