Ice/Water Rescue

2017 was the County of Wetaskiwin Fire Departments first full year of providing ice and water rescue to Pigeon Lake, with revenue coming from fundraisers, grants & Summer Villages. Training was completed, and they

assisted in one rescue and responded to four other calls on the lake. The Search and Rescue Sea Doo will be docked at Silver Beach this year.

Garbage - Big Bins

The Summer Village has in the past offered two “big bin” services in the spring and fall for residents to use to put their garbage. Costs have been increasing for this service, so to help keep taxes from rising, there will only be a big bin service offered in the spring.

The regular garbage pickup that is weekly during the summer (April 30 - October 29, 2018), and bi-weekly during the winter will continue. The Summer Village is also working on other options for residents having access to transfer stations; we will update you if an agreement is made regarding access to the transfer stations.

Fibre Project

Missing Link Internet will be installing fibre (*really fast, reliable internet!*) around Pigeon Lake, starting in 2019. There will be no cost to the municipality, and the Summer Village of Silver Beach will be approving their work plan to install the fibre line in the road right-of-way. Their current proposed cost for residents are:

- \$500 if the resident wants to hook up and sign a 1 year contract;
- Packages could be \$100 per month, with a reduction to \$10 / month while away.
- \$1500 if the resident wants conduit installed but no internet package;
- \$3000 - \$6500 to come back later for installation.
