Bylaw No. 109

A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SILVER BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO IMPOSE A PENALTY ON UNPAID TAXES

Under the authority vested in the Council of the Summer Village of Silver Beach in the Province of Alberta by the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 1980, M-26 and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 117 – 118 of *The Municipal Taxation Act*, R.S.A. 1980, c. M 31 the Council of the Summer Village of Silver Beach enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw #25 and #97 are hereby rescinded.
2. That where any current taxes remain unpaid 30 days after the mailing of the tax notices, there shall be added thereto by way of a penalty an amount of 10% of the unpaid taxes.
3. That further where any taxes remain unpaid after the 31st day of December of the year for which the same are levied there shall be added thereto by way of penalty an amount 12% of the unpaid taxes for each succeeding year, after the year for which the unpaid taxes are levied so long as the taxes remain unpaid. Such penalty shall be added on the 1st day of January 1985 and on the first day of January of each succeeding year thereafter in respect of any taxes remaining unpaid after the 31st day of December of the year for which the same are levied.

Read a first time the 19th day of June 1984. Carried.

Read a second time the 19th day of June 1984. Carried.

It was moved by Councillor Marshall that authority be granted to proceed with all three readings at this meeting. Carried unanimously.

Read a third time and finally passed the 19th day of June 1984.
